{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} • On an Android phone the most common way to cancel Norton is by going into the Google Play Store app, tapping your profile picture at the top right, choosing "Payments and Subscriptions" then "Subscriptions," finding Norton in the list, and tapping "Cancel Subscription," which will then stop future charges while keeping your protection active until the current cycle ends .

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} Another useful tip is to take a screenshot of the final cancellation confirmation screen on your phone whether you cancel through Google Play, the App Store, or Norton's site because this gives you proof in case you are billed later and need to dispute the charge .

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} Norton subscriptions are typically billed annually or monthly, so when you cancel on your phone you usually retain access to Norton services like antivirus and identity protection until the end of your paid period, which means you are not left unprotected immediately but you will not be billed again afterward .

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}}  $\equiv$  If you want a refund after canceling on your phone you need to follow the refund policy of the platform where you purchased the subscription, so for Android you request a refund through Google Play, for iPhone you go through Apple, and for direct Norton purchases you must contact Norton support directly ...

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} **%** If you face errors when canceling Norton on your phone like the subscription not showing up, it might be that the subscription is under a different account or you may need to update your app store billing information, so double check everything carefully before contacting support .

Canceling Norton subscription on your phone gives you flexibility if you want to switch to another antivirus provider or rely on built-in phone protections like Google Play Protect or Apple's native security features, and many users find this adequate depending on their needs .

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} \ Always look for a confirmation email after canceling on your phone because this is the final proof that the cancellation went through and without it you may find Norton or your app store still charging you during the next billing cycle ... \{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} \ If you still see Norton charges after canceling on your phone you should immediately contact your payment provider or bank to block the charges while simultaneously reaching out to Norton support with your cancellation confirmation to resolve the dispute \(\frac{\tau}{\text{in}}\).

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} © For people who purchased Norton subscriptions via promotional offers or bundles, cancellation on the phone may involve slightly different steps but the principle remains the same—log into the account where you purchased it and disable auto renewal  $\nearrow$ .

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} In summary the easiest way to cancel Norton subscription on phone is through the subscriptions section of the platform you bought it from whether that is Google Play or Apple App Store, and if it was purchased directly then the Norton website or support team must be used ...

{{{833}}} {{{743}}} {{{5300}}} ⑥ Following these steps ensures you stop charges, protect your finances, and maintain control over which services run on your device, and with proof in hand you can rest easy knowing Norton won't continue billing after your cancellation request .
